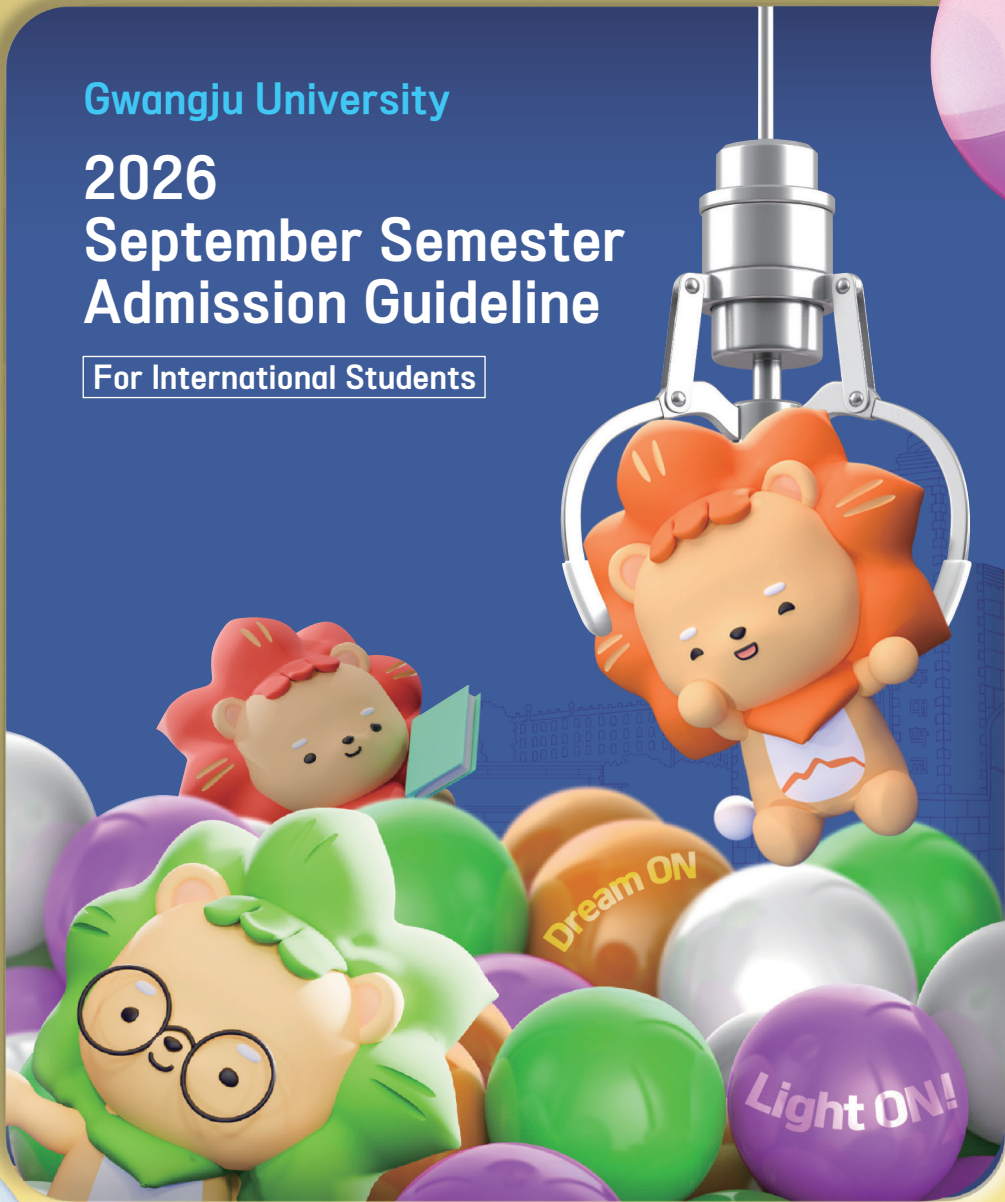

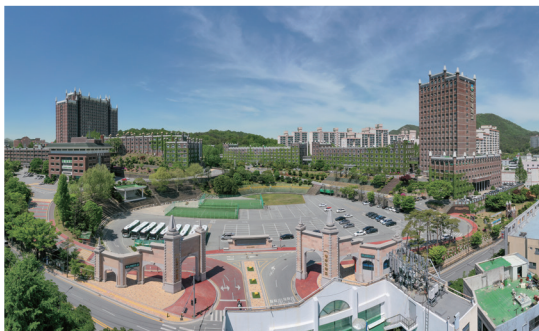

## 4. Eligibility

All	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Applicants whose both parents are non-Korean nationals</li> <li>- Dual nationals and stateless persons are not recognized as foreign applicants</li> </ul>	
Freshman	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Applicants who completed(or are expected to complete) primary and secondary education equivalent to Korean schooling</li> </ul>	
Transfer	2nd year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Applicants who have completed(or are expected to complete) at least one year at a 4-year accredited university in Korea or abroad</li> </ul>
	3rd year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Applicants who have completed(or are expected to complete) at least two years at a 4-year accredited university in Korea or abroad, or who have graduated(or are expected to graduate) from a junior college</li> </ul>
	4th year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Applicants who have graduated(or are expected to graduate) from a 3-year junior college program in Korea or abroad in a related field of study</li> </ul>

	Chinese Track	No language proficiency requirement (Must complete 200 hours of Korean language training after admission)
Graduation	Korean Track	TOPIK Level 4 or higher, or GU TOPIK Level 4 or higher (Level 3 or higher for Arts and Physical Education majors)

- Freshman: high school diploma and academic transcript	- Original Apostille or Consular Authentication issued by the Korean Embassy/Consulate
- Transfer: certificate of degree(or certificate of completion) from a junior college or higher, and academic transcript	- Academic Credential Verification Report(if applicable)
- Financial Guarantee Documents	- KRW 16,000,000
- Certificate of Employment and Income Statement of the applicant's parents	
- Certificate of TOPIK or English proficiency test score

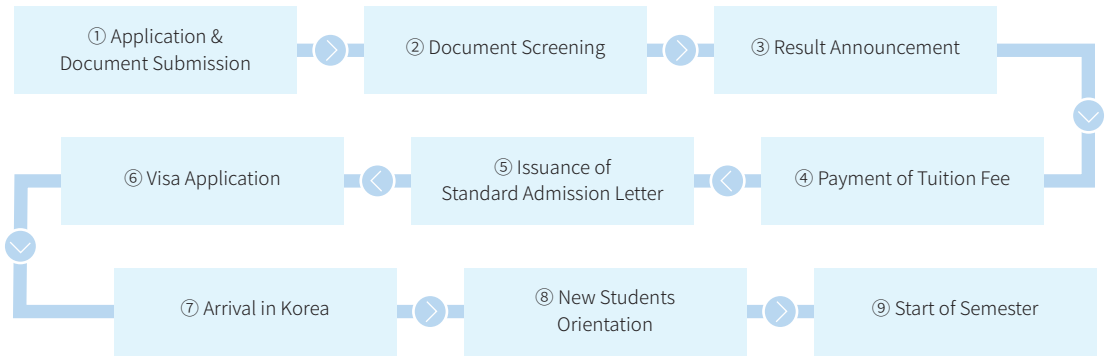

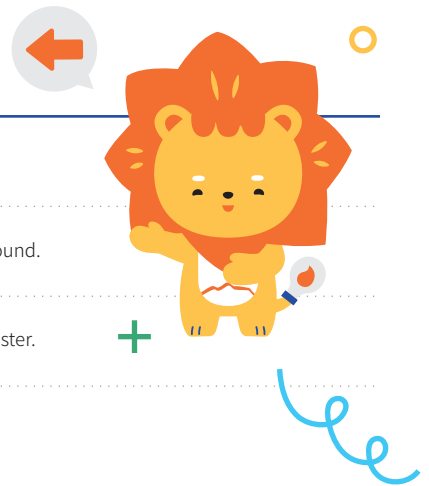
Mandatory enrollment in the National Health Insurance (approx. KRW 130,000/month, paid by the student)

- 3 Freshman students are not permitted to take a leave of absence in their first semester.
- 4 Admitted students must pay the tuition fee within the designated period; failure to do so may result in cancellation of admission.
- 5 All students are required to enroll in the National Health Insurance of Korea.
